1	"(a) during any recess there shall be no votes,
2	except there shall be not more than 13 recess weeks
3	during each calendar year; or
4	"(b) during any week in which there is a holi-
5	day, then votes shall be held on 4 days.".
6	(b) The amendment made by subsection (a) shall take
7	effect with the first session of Congress beginning on the
8	date of adoption of this resolution.
