I am requesting funding for the planning phase of the Metropolitan Transit System Facility Resiliency Planning Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System, located at 1255 Imperial Avenue, Suite 1000, San Diego, CA 92101.

The funding would be used to develop engineering and nature-based solutions that strengthen the safety, security, and resilience of a critical hub in the regional transit network during recurrent flooding events.
