A BILL

To provide for a report on the role of incubators and accelerators in the commercialization of federally funded research and regional economic development.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Building Opportunity
- 5 for Student Startups Act" or the "BOSS Act".

SEC. 2. NATIONAL ACADEMIES REPORT ON INCUBATORS 2 AND ACCELERATORS. 3 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment 4 of this Act, the Under Secretary of Commerce for Stand-5 ards and Technology shall enter into an arrangement with the National Academy of Sciences to conduct a study on 6 7 the role of incubators and accelerators, including univer-8 sity-based incubators and accelerators, in the commer-9 cialization of federally funded research and regional economic development. The study shall— 10 11 (1) include an examination of metrics for com-12 paring startups that have and have not completed 13 incubator or accelerator programs, and include the 14 role of incubators and accelerators in developing re-15 gional innovation clusters; and 16 (2) identify best practices in the structure, 17 goals, operation, management, and funding mecha-18 nisms of leading incubators and accelerators.
